

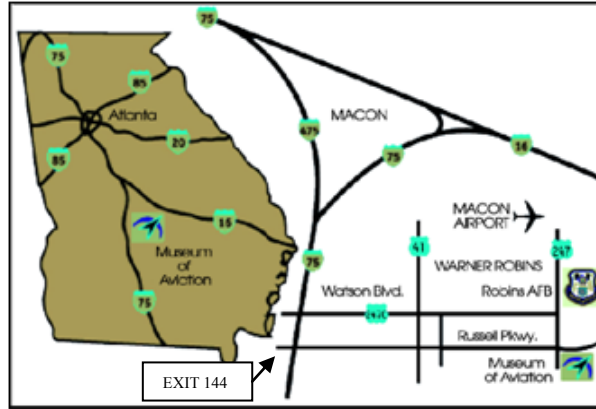

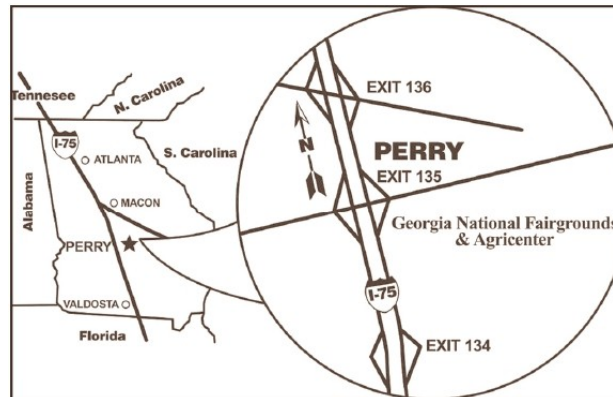

Warner Robins, the 9th largest city in Georgia, is a forever growing friendly city, where one finds a blend of bustling city life mixed with a touch of laid-back rural charm. Officially chartered by the state of Georgia in 1943, its geographical assets attracted the Air Force (then known as Army Air Corps) to the area during World War II. At the urging of Colonel Thomas, the depot's first commander, the growing town changed its name to Warner Robins in honor of Brigadier General Augustine Warner Robins. After the Korean conflict, Robins Air Force Base was permanently established and is now Georgia's largest single site industrial complex with a solid community foundation of military roots accounting for its openness, acceptance, and tolerance which so many enjoy today.

Aerospace Industry Committee

The Aerospace Industry Committee is organized for the purpose of preserving, advancing and enhancing the community of aerospace and defense industries in the Warner Robins area and for the advancement of their collective interests.

Warner Robins Air Logistics Center

Robins Air Force Base, is the home of Warner Robins Air Logistics Center, the 78th Air Base Wing, and more than 60 other units that make up a vital part of the Air Force war fighting team. It is the largest single site industrial complex in Georgia, employing a work force of over 25,000 civilian, contractor, and military members.
